Scam accused returns from Dubai, quizzed on mantris' ties

New Delhi: The Enforcement Directorate detained Mohammad Mansoor Khan of IMA Jewels after he landed at IGI airport from Dubai on Friday and took him to the agency's headquarters where he was questioned on his claim that he had paid huge sums of money to two ministers of the Congress-JD(S) government in Karnataka.

Khan is accused of money laundering in a Rs 4,000 crore ponzi scam where over 40,000 small investors from the minority community were cheated. Sources said Khan had contacted the investigating officers to join the probe immediately. His detention is significant considering that the state government faces a vote of confidence in the assembly.

One of the ministers in the H D Kumaraswamy ministry had even declared in his election affidavit of having received Rs 5 crore from IMA Jewels. Khan had also accused Congress MLA Roshan Baig of taking Rs 400 crore from him and not returning it.

Illegals have doctored NRC lists, Centre & Assam tell SC

SC To Hear All Stakeholders On July 23

New Delhi: The Supreme Court decided on Friday to hear all stakeholders on July 23 on pleas of the Centre and Assam government for reverification of 20% of the final draft NRC data which they claimed was required to correct "wrongful inclusion of lakhs of illegal Bangladeshi migrants and exclusion of indigenous Assamese" in border districts. They also sought extension of the July 31 deadline for publication of the final NRC.

Arguing before a bench of Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi and Justice R F Nariman, the Centre and Assam, thro-

ugh solicitor general Tushar Mehta, alleged that local NRC officials, in collusion with illegal migrants, manipulated lists to benefit illegals and disadvantage genuine citizens.

"The sample reverification process may be tweaked a bit to exclude involvement of local NRC officials so as to maintain public faith in the fairness of the process prior to publication of the final

NRC. The exclusions are far less compared to lakhs of illegal migrants getting included in NRC in districts bordering Bangladesh. Reverification of data of persons in one district must be done by NRC officials of another to eliminate local pressure for wrongful inclusion," Mehta said.

While pleading for extension of the July 31 final-NRC deadline, Mehta said: "Ille-

gal migrants have no place in the country. India cannot be the refugee capital of the world."

In the draft NRC published on July 30 last year, 2,89,83,677 people were included and 40,70,707 names were excluded. Of those excluded, 37,59,630 were rejected and 2,48,077 were kept on hold. At the end of filing of claims and objections on December 31 last year, about 36.2 lakh claims for inclusion and about 2 lakh applications objecting to inclusions were filed.

NRC coordinator Prateek Hajela told the court that public engagement for scrutiny of claims and objections were "almost over" and that a supplementary NRC would be published on July 31 detailing names to be included and excluded. However, he said publication of the final NRC could be possible only in the first week of August as against the July 31 deadline.

NRC hearings postponed due to floods

Guwahati: NRC hearings in several Assam districts have been postponed as over 100 NRC Seva Kendras (NSKs) remain inundated in the raging flood waters.

Officials at the NRC coordinator office here have, however, refused to reveal the exact number of NSKs that are under water on the ground that NRC-related issues are currently being heard in the Supreme Court. There are 2,500 NSKs across the state.

In Barpeta, which is the worst hit, an NRC official said nobody turned up for the July 16 hearing. Nearly 11 lakh people in Barpeta district, about 95 km from here, have been hit. "The hearing has been postponed to July 22," the official said.

In Dhubri, several NSKs in the seven flood-hit revenue circles have been hit. Hearings in some of the NSKs have been postponed.

PDP leader's PSO shot dead in J&K

Srinagar: Terrorists killed the personal security officer (PSO) of PDP leader and Mehbooba Mufti's cousin, Sajad Mufti, outside a mosque in Baba Mohalla area of Bijbehara in south Kashmir's Anantnag district on Friday. The PDP leader was offering prayers at the shrine of Ziyarat Baba Naseeruddin Gazi when the attack took place. His PSO, constable Farooq Ahmad (35), was standing guard outside the premises when unidentified assailants shot him and fled with his service rifle, said sources. Ahmad, who was from Dirpora Khyam area, was rushed to the Bijbehara sub-district hospital where he was declared brought dead, said cops. No terror outfit has claimed responsibility for the attack so far. **TNN**

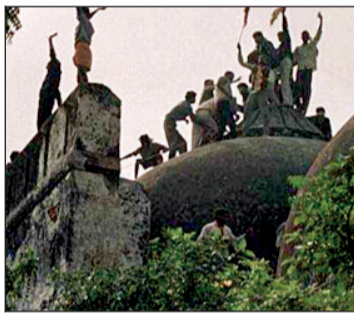
SC sets April 18 date for verdict in Babri case

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday directed the special CBI court in Lucknow to deliver the verdict in the trial against senior BJP members L K Advani, M M Joshi, Uma Bharati and others in the Babri Masjid demolition case within nine months.

A bench of Justices R F Nariman and Surya Kant asked district and sessions judge Surendra Kumar Yadav, who was asked by the SC in April 2017 to complete the trial within two years, to wrap up hearings in six months and deliver the verdict in nine months, which means the judge will have to pass the judgment by April 18 next year.

As the trial in the case had run into a fresh roadblock with Yadav scheduled to retire on September 30, the

bench asked the Uttar Pradesh government to extend his tenure after consulting the Allahabad high court to ensure uninterrupted proceedings in the case.

The court said the tenure would be extended till the judge pronounces

verdict in the case which has reached the fag end. It also asked the trial judge to keep oral hearings of the parties to "bare minimum" and allow them to file written submissions to complete proceedings within the stipulated time period.

The court directed the UP chief secretary to comply with its order on extension of the judge's tenure and file a compliance report within four weeks. It passed the order after the judge wrote to the court informing that proceedings in the case were nearing completion and he needed six months to wrap up, but he was to retire on September 30.

As Yadav has been hearing the case for the last two years on a day-to-day basis and the trial would be delayed if a new judge is appointed, the SC said his tenure must be extended for time-bound disposal of the case.
